DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 27th April 2022

Combined agents reported a increased yarding this week of 2863 cattle. The Market was firm to slightly dearer across all areas. Cows sold to a dearer trend across all weight categories with some very good lines of Western cows yarded, cows averaged 10 - 15 cents dearer with all processors operating. Heavy steers and Heifers were in very short supply however held firm on previous week.

Heavy feeder classes were firm with select pens of Quality steers 5 cents dearer. Trade weight feeder cattle were in short supply with trade heifers firm from 540 - 565 cents. Trade steers also firm from 560 - 610 cents. Weaner cattle were firm to 20 dearer quality related for all weight classes with some strong local support for the medium weight weaner steers.

PTIC cows Preg tested to To Simmental bulls sold to 2750.00 with Crossbred cows & calves selling from \$2650 to \$3600.00 pending quality. Isolated sales to \$4000.00 were seen on single units.
