

## DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wendesday 20th April 2022

Combined agents reported a reduced yarding this week of 1581 Cattle. The market was firm to slightly dearer across the board with the better-quality lines of cattle still being a sort after commodity. Heavy cows sold to a strong panel of buyers with all processers operating and topped at 368c/kg. A good run of 70 cow's ex Taroom sold to an average of 362c/kg. Heavy heifers to kill sold well averaging from 400-440c/kg with the lighter trade weight heifers making from 520-540c/kg.

Heavy feeder cattle were in short supply however the better lines of steers in the right weight bracket still reaching the top of the current market from 520-540c/kg.

Once again, the weaner and restocker market was still quite strong. Weaner steers sold well with the light weights ranging from 750-800c/kg and the heavier end making from 630-680c/kg. Weaner heifers were slightly easier this week however still making from 570-600c/kg in the heavier end.
