DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 11th May 2022

A reduced yarding of 2355 cattle came to hand for this week's Dalby sale. The market was firm to slightly dearer across the board with light weight weaner categories seeing rises of 20-30 cents however this was reflective in the quality. The better lines of cows yarded were firm on last week with the best cows topping at 378.2c/kg.

Heavy steers and heifers sold to a strong market as did export feeder steers and heifers with heavy feeders 460 kgs to 5.50. Trade weight feeder steers were in demand this week with steers making from 580-6320 c/kg. A mixed quality yarding of restocker and weaner cattle came to hand, all selling to a very competitive panel of buyers.

Light weight steers topped at over 826.2c/kg with plenty of sales from 680-720c/kg. Similarly in the heifer market, the better lines of heifers sold very well 20-30 cent rises with the lesser quality pens selling to a firm trend. Open auction cows and calves sold fully firm and a line of EU PTIC Angus cows topped at \$2820.
