## DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 18th May 2022

Combined agents saw a reduced yarding of 1935 cattle for this week's Dalby sale. With continued widespread rain again throughout last week numbers were limited.

A full panel of export buyers were in attendance creating a firm to dearer market. Cows sold very well topping at 376c/kg with plenty of sales from 350-370c/kg along with heavy bulls topping at 346c/kg. A good yarding of heavy steers to slaughter came to hand all selling to a firm market. Heavy feeder steers sold to a dearer trend with limited buyers in attendance topping at a shade over 540c/kg.

Trade feeders sold to a competitive panel of buyers, with the steers making from 570-610c/kg and the heifer portion from 530-560c/kg.

Weaner and restocker cattle again sold to a very firm buying panel with steers returning to the paddock topping at over 750c/kg. Similarly the heifers topped at 670c/kg with a large percentage from 600-640c/kg. A very reduced yarding of cows and calves came to hand and topped at \$3800.
