## DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 22nd June 2022

Combined agents yarded 4659 cattle for this weeks Dalby sale. With a mixed quality yarding of cattle the market eased across the board however held strong for the better quality lines of cattle. The export market was 15-20c/kg easier with the lead of the cows making from 350-360c/kg. Heavy steers to kill sold from 380-420c/kg and heifers in the similar range sold from 360-400c/kg. Feeder cattle sold firm with steers suitable for the 100 day export market selling from 520-540c/kg. Trade weight steers eased slightly however store condition steers returning to the paddock (320-380kg) sold to a very strong market making from 560-600c/kg. Feeder heifers suitable for the domestic market sold well, making from 500-540c/kg.

The second round again showed some signs of easing in the market. Steers returning to the paddock sold very well however were slightly cheaper. Light weight steers sold from 650-700c/kg with the heavier steers selling from 590-650c/kg. Heifers saw more of a drop in the market with light weight heifers selling from 550-600c/kg and the heavier weaner heifers selling from 480-540c/kg. Once again a mixed yarding of cows and calves came to hand topping at \$2650. Overall, the market was easier across the board however the better lines of cattle are still a sort after commodity with less of a demand for the secondary lines of cattle.
