

## DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 1st June 2022

Combined agents yarded a shade over 3400 cattle for this week's Dalby sale. A mixed yarding of cattle came to hand selling to a varied market, with some descriptions selling to a reduced market and others to a dearer trend. The export market was firm to easier across the board however this was reflective of the quality of the cattle.

Feeder steers sold to an easier market in the heavier export market however the trade weight feeder steers sold to a more vibrant market. In addition, the trade feeder heifers sold to a dearer trend also.

A good quality yarding of weaner and restocker cattle came to hand for the second round all selling to dearer trends. A big lift was seen in the Angus weaner steer market which then in turn also lifted the cross bred market as well. Weaner and restocker heifers sold to a competitive panel of buyers being dearer by 10-15c/kg.

A small number of cows and calves came to hand however sold well. First calf Charolais cross heifers and calves sold for \$3650.
