

## DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 13th July 2022

Combined agents yarded 4529 cattle for this weeks Dalby Sale. An increased yarding once again saw a mixture of cattle come to hand and selling to an easier trend across the board. The export market was varied in quality with the better finished kill cattle selling very well. Heavy cows sold well ranging from 290-340c/kg, with heavy bulls ranging 270-320c/kg and light weight feeder bulls from 350-380c/kg. Heavy steers to kill sold to an easier market, ranging from 370-390c/kg. Feeder cattle once again were slightly easier with steers suitable for the 100-day feedlot market selling from 460-490c/kg and trade weight steers selling from 480-530c/kg. Feeder heifers were firm on current market trends selling from 440-480c/kg.

The second round sold to a softer trend this week with prices still being a representation of quality. Heavier weight weaner steers returning to the paddock sold from 480-550c/kg with lighter weights selling from 530-600c/kg, with the odd sale over 600c/kg. Heifers were very much the same with heavier weaner heifers selling from 460-490c/kg and light weight heifers ranging from 470-530c/kg. Again, the good quality lines of steers and heifers are still in demand.
