

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 27th July 2022

Combined agents yarded 2298 cattle for this weeks Dalby Sale.

Overall, the market was slightly easier across the board compared to last week however the better lines of cattle are still selling quite well.

Heavy kill cows sold firm on last week's rates with the lead of the cows selling to 315-320c/kg. Bulls sold to an easier trend as did heavy kill steers. Feeder cattle on a whole sold to a softer trend with export feeder steers topping at 478c/kg and trade weight steers reaching 500c/kg.

Feeder heifers for the domestic market were slightly easier topping at 470c/kg. A reduced quality yarding of weaner and restocker cattle came to hand and once again sold to a softer trend. Weaner steers returning to the paddock sold from 520-570c/kg with heifers selling from 430-490c/kg.
