

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 10th August 2022

Combined agents yarded just shy of 3000 cattle for this weeks Dalby sale. The market improved for most descriptions especially the export and restocker markets. With southern processers in the market, cows along with heavy kill steers and heifers were very strong. Cows sold to a very buoyant market with the majority selling from 340-370c/kg. A large run of PTIC cows sold c/kg made from 380-430c/kg. Feeder cattle were firm to slightly dearer however few feeder cattle came to hand. Trade weight kill cattle sold well however again only a small sample to quote on. A mixed quality run of second round cattle came to hand, all selling to a dearer trend. The heavier end of the weaner steers sold from 480-540c/kg with the lighter end selling very well from 540-620c/kg. A big improvement in the heifer market this week saw heavier weaner heifers sell from 440-500c/kg and light weight heifers selling from 480-540c/kg. Very few open auction cattle were yarded, however 1 pen of PTIC Angus cows sold for \$2400.
