

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 7th September 2022

Combined agents yarded 3363 cattle for this weeks Dalby sale. With decent falls of rain through the end of last week a reduced yarding came to hand and varied in quality. Cows were slightly easier this week with the absence of a portion of southern buyers, however still sold to strong rates.

Bulls sold to a very firm panel of buyers as did heavy kill steers and heifers. Feeder cattle were in short supply and sold to a dearer trend. Trade feeders steers sold from 530-600c/kg and heifers from 510-540c/kg. Heavy feeder steers sold very well topping at 485 c/kg.

Weaners and yearlings in the second round continued to be in strong demand. Heavier yearling steers returning to the paddock 300-370kg sold to a competitive panel of buyers as did lightweight weaner steers that topped at over 700c/kg. The heifer market was fully firm with the heavier end selling from 500-540c/kg and the lightweight heifers topping over 600c/kg.
