

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 12th October 2022

Combined agents yarded 2674 Cattle for this weeks Dalby sale. Very much a rain effected yarding, however the market was firm to dearer across the board. Heavy kill cows sold to a firm market with cows selling from 370-385c/kg at the top with few well finished cows coming to hand. Heavy bulls sold well, making from 350-390c/kg. Very limited number of Bullocks were yarded however prices remain firm on those yarded. Once again a small amount of feeder cattle were yarded however the better quality lines sold well with heavy feeder steers selling from 480-495c/kg and trade weight steers from 550-580c/kg. Finished kill heifers sold firm as did trade feeder heifers.

A smaller offering of second round cattle came to hand however sold to a very strong panel of buyers. Steers returning to the paddock in the lighter weight brackets sold to 760c/kg with the majority selling from 650-680c/kg. Quality lines of heifers sold to a dearer trend with heifers in the 280-300kg range selling to 560c/kg and lighter weight heifers selling from 550-590c/kg. Once again, secondary lines of cattle were easier however this price is reflective of quality. A line of PTIC Angus cows were yarded, selling to \$2450.
