

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 19th October 2022

Combined agents yarded 5075 cattle for this weeks Dalby sale. A very good quality yarding of cattle came to hand and once again sold to a very competitive panel of buyers. Export cattle sold firm on past weeks rates with cows slightly being slightly easier however could have been quality driven.

Heavy bulls sold very well, selling to 395c/kg. Heavy kill cattle sold well as did trade weight heifers to slaughter. With rain on the forecast feeder cattle sold to a dearer trend across the board with mid weight heavy feeders 430-440kg selling to 540c/kg. Heavy export feeders 440-530 kg sold to 500c/kg to average 490c/kg. Trade weight feeder steers and heifers were in strong demand, selling in line with current grid prices.

Restocker and weaner cattle in the second round were in strong demand and sold to a dearer trend. Good quality lines of weaner steers sold over 700c/kg with plenty of sales from 620-670c/kg. Second round heifers were much the same with heifers selling over 600c/kg. Overall, a very good quality yarding of cattle sold to a dearer trend across the board.
