

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 8th February 2023

Combined agents yarded 4769 cattle for this week's Dalby sale. Export cattle sold well with heavy cows topping at 308.2c/kg with a large percentage selling from 270-290c/kg and secondary store cows selling from 240-260c/kg. Bulls sold well, with heavy kill bulls selling up to 280c/kg with lighter, younger feeder type bulls selling to 300-320c/kg. A good yarding of heavy kill steers and heifers were yarded and sold well with the leads of the steers selling from 350-360c/kg and heifers selling to similar rates.

Feeder cattle were firm on last week's rates with heavy export feeder steers 450-480kg sold to 406c/kg with lighter 420/430 kg steers selling to 420c/kg. Feeder heifers for the domestic market were in short supply however sold from 370-390c/kg with a few sales over 400c/kg. A good sample of second round weaner and restocker cattle came to hand and sold to a competitive panel of buyers.

Good quality Euro and British cross backgrounder steers sold over 500c/kg with the more crossbred steers from 380-450c/kg. Very similar in the heifer market, the better softer heifers are still selling to a strong market, making from 400-440c/kg.
