

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 12th April 2023

Combined agents yarded 1416 cattle for this week's Dalby sale. A smaller yarding this week saw the market firm to slightly stronger in spots with good quality pens of weaners and feeders coming to hand. Heavy cows were in short supply however those that were yarded sold quite well topping at over 270c/kg with a fair percentage selling from 240-255c/kg. Good young kill bulls sold up to 270c/kg with lighter younger feeder type bulls selling to 290-315 c/kg. Very few heavy steers and heifers were yarded, however steers topped 310c/kg and heifers at 300c/kg. Feeder cattle saw the market firm on last week's rates with heavy export feeder steers 450-480 kg sold to 360c/kg with lighter 380/430 kg steers selling to 385c/kg.

Trade feeder heifers suitable for the supermarket trade were dearer on last week's market selling to a top of 355c/kg for a run of good Charolais cross heifers and lesser quality lines selling from 300-320c/kg. Second round weaner and restocker steers saw the market hold firm on last week's rates with a pen of Angus steers topping at 501.2c/kg with most pens selling from 440-460 c/kg. Weaner and restocker heifers sold firm again on last week's prices with good Euro and British heifers selling to 360c/kg with lesser lines selling from 280-320c/kg.
