

DALBY MARKET REPORT - Wednesday 26th April 2023

Combined agents yarded 7450 cattle for this week's Dalby sale. A considerable increase on last week's yarding saw the market firm to slightly stronger on export classes with some very good quality runs of Cows and weaners coming to hand. Heavy cows saw the market sell quite well topping at 276c/kg with a fair percentage selling from 255-265c/kg. Good young kill bulls sold up to 316c/kg however average 285 - 290 cents, with lighter younger feeder type bulls selling to 290-315 c/kg. Very few heavy steers and heifers were yarded, however steers topped 318c/kg and heifers at 308c/kg. Feeder cattle saw the market firm to slightly stronger on last week's rates with heavy export feeder steers 450-480 kg sold to 369c/kg with lighter 380/430 kg steers selling to 394c/kg with some good lines being offered.

Trade feeder heifers suitable for the supermarket trade were dearer on last week's market selling to a top of 365c/kg and lesser quality lines selling from 300-320c/kg. Second round weaner and restocker steers saw the market struggle on last week's rates with most pens selling from 400-430 c/kg. Weaner and restocker heifers lost ground on last week's prices with good Euro and British heifers selling to 330c/kg average 292c/kg with lesser lines selling from 250-285 c/kg.
